



SEASON 2009-2010

Week 2 Reports

Premier Division

Nelson 1st moved to the top of the early Premier Division table after comprehensively defeating Frames 4th 7-0. James Gillard was in fine form for Nelson, recording a 51 break. Promoted side Frames 3rd continued their good start to the season with a 6-1 home victory over Nelson 2nd which puts them in second, with Adam Prewett compiling a 34 break, his second 30+ break in as many weeks. Champions Kenilworth Cons 1st battled to a 4-3 home win over Harbury 1st, with Ben Deller chipping in with a 31 break for the champions. Priors 1st squandered a 3-0 lead before eventually overcoming Lillington 1st 4-3. Damien Dowds & Dean Young both compiled 32 breaks for Priors. Breaks from John Beesley (57) and Cain Magnus (50) helped Cubbington 1st to a 5-2 victory over Warwick Cons 1st. Frames 1st bounced back from their opening day defeat to win 6-1 at home to Lillington 2nd, with Eddie Starzynski compiling the weeks' top break with an excellent run of 60. Dave Nash (42 break) was also in good form for the home side. The match between Kenilworth S&S F/C and Home Guard 1st was postponed.

A Division

The early pace setters in the A Division are Frames 2nd and Warwick Cons 2nd. Both recorded away victories this week to go joint top. The Frames side won 4-3 away at Priors 3rd, and the "cons" were 5-2 winners at Bishops Tachbrook. Lillington 3rd won 4-3 against Lillington Bowls despite only having 6 players available for the match. Nelson 3rd also only had 6 players available for their match away against a Priors 2nd, who themselves only just scraped together a team. Nelson emerging 5-2 winners. Cubbington 2nd defeated Oakhouse 4-3 and Home Guard 2nd won a close home match 4-3 against Leamington Liberals. In the week's remaining match, Harbury 2nd won 5-2 in their home match against Kenilworth Cons 2nd.
