Cubbington 1st are three points further back in third after a 5-2 win at Frames 4th. Rob Wigley (40), Vivek Makh (37) and Dean White (33) all compiling breaks. Frames 1st were excellent 5-2 winners at Harbury 1st and Home Guard 1st won for the second week running, this time a 4-3 home success over Lillington 2nd.
