Premier Division

In the clash of the week in the Warwickshire Beer Leamington & District Snooker League, the top two sides faced each other, as leaders Nelson 1st played host to Priors 1st. Nelson went into the match with an excellent recent record against their rivals, but an excellent team performance from Priors saw them win the match 5-2 to move back to the top of the table. Dean Young continued his good form with a 31 break. Frames 1st closed the gap between themselves and Nelson to just one point after a 7-0 whitewash victory over Nelson 2nd, the second 7-0 defeat in a row for the strugglers. Cubbington 1st are a point further behind in fourth following a closely fought 4-3 home victory over Frames 3rd. Adam Prewett was the star of the night for Frames, compiling a 72 break. Vivek Makh also recorded a 34 break in the match. Kenilworth Cons 1st won 5-2 at home against Lillington 1st, with Ben Deller (56) and Ian Wagstaff (40) among the breaks. Home Guard 1st won their third match in a row with a 4-3 victory away at Frames 4th, and Harbury 1st were 4-3 winners away at Lillington 2nd, Paul Murphy compiling a 37 break for Harbury.. Warwick Cons 1st won their first match of the season away at Kenilworth S&S F/C, emerging 5-2 winners.

Harbury 2nd remain in pole position in the A Division following an impressive 6-1 victory over fellow promotion hopefuls Frames 2nd. Ed Hewer recorded a 31 break for Harbury whilst Brinder Sidhu chipped in with a 30 for Frames. Home Guard 2nd looked on course for an excellent result when 3-0 up on Oakhouse after the first night of their home match, but a great fight back from the visitors saw them take all four frames on the second night to win 4-3. Finally, Kenilworth Cons 2nd were 4-3 winners away at Nelson 3rd.
