### Premier Division

Adam Prewett was once again in form for Frames, compiling a 30 break in his frame win over Ian Wagstaff. Cubbington 1st lost their 100% record away at Home Guard 1st, who run out 4-3 winners to continue their own good form. Harbury 1st were excellent 6-1 winners over Frames 4th and Nelson 2nd gained an very good 4-3 win over Lillington 2nd, for whom Paul Barrow recorded a 30 break.
