Daz York (43) and Nigel Croft (34) recording breaks for Nelson and captain Brian Higgins a 33 break for Frames. Frames 1st pulled level on points with Nelson 1st after they enjoyed a 7-0 romp away at Lillington 1st. Champions Kenilworth Cons 1st also enjoyed a 7-0 win at home against Kenilworth S&S F/C. Ben Deller (50) and Craig Campbell (32) among the breaks for the champions. Cubbington 1st continued their good form with a 6-1 win away at Harbury 1st, with Mark White (53) and Vic Makh (39) compiling breaks for the villagers. Home Guard 1st won 5-2 away at Nelson 2nd and Warwick Cons 1st moved out of the relegation zone with a 5-2 win over Lillington 2nd.
