### FRAMES GO TOP AS CHAMPIONS RETURN TO FORM

Frames 1st moved to the top of the Warwickshire Beer Premier Division table after a hard fought 4-3 victory over rivals Frames 3rd. In the match of the week, current champions Kenilworth Cons 1st travelled to play Nelson 1st. The champions who have been struggling by their standards this season showed a welcome return to form, winning a close match 4-3, thanks mainly to a superb colours clearance from Glen Powell to beat Phil Parkin. Parkin compiled a 31 break during the match and Adam Ashley also chipped in with a 35 break. Priors 1st lost their unbeaten record away at Home Guard 1st, who's 5-2 win means they have now beaten three of the top sides in the division. Harbury 1st won 6-1 at home to Nelson 2nd and Cubbington 1st were 5-2 winners in their home match against Kenilworth S&S F/C. Warwick Cons 1st defeated strugglers Frames 4th 6-1 and in the week's remaining match Lillington 2nd won their derby match against Lillington 1st 5-2.

Priors 3rd sprung the surprise of the week in the A Division, running out easy 6-1 winners against runaway leaders Harbury 2nd, the win lifting Priors up to fourth place. Basement side Oakhouse caused an upset when they defeated third placed Warwick Cons 2nd 4-3, and Frames 2nd also received a blow to their chances of catching the leaders when they lost 5-2 at Nelson 3rd, for whom Tim Sambhi compiled a 36 break. There was a good win for Priors 2nd, defeating Home Guard 2nd 5-2, and in-form Bishops Tachbrook are up to third place following a 4-3 win at Lillington 3rd. Lillington Bowls won 4-3 away at Leamington Liberals and Kenilworth Cons 2nd enjoyed a 5-2 success against Cubbington 2nd.
