Phil Parkin was in fine form, compiling break of 41, 35 & 32 in defeating his dad Terry. Ian Weatherstone also compiled a 41 break for Nelson. Priors 1st slipped to their second defeat in a row in going down 4-3 at home to Harbury 1st. Damien Dowds compiled a 40 break for Priors. Champions Kenilworth Cons 1st continued their good form of late with a 5-2 home win over Frames 1st, who led the table going into the week's matches. Andy Devey recorded a 31 break for Frames. A superb 64 break from Vivek Makh, and a 41 break from Mark White helped Cubbington 1st to a 6-1 success at Nelson 2nd and a 34 break from Terry Heritage helped Lillington 2nd to a 4-3 win away at Frames 3rd. Warwick Cons 1st defeated in form Home Guard 1st 4-3 and Lillington 1st claimed a 4-3 win over Frames 4th.
