

Warwickshire Beer Leamington & District Snooker League

Frames 1st lead the table by 4 points at the half way stage after an excellent 5-2 win away at title rivals Nelson 1st. Phil Parkin (52) and Neal Stribbling (35) were among the breaks for Nelson. The other big game of the week saw another 5-2 away win as Cubbington 1st emerged victorious over Priors 1st. AN entertaining match saw breaks from Vic Makh (58), Vivek Makh (41), Dean White (34), John Beesley (33) and Stan Makh (30). Defending champions Kenilworth Cons 1st are right back in the title hunt now after a comprehensive 7-0 win over strugglers Frames 4th. Adam Ashley (65) and Ian Wagstaff (40) compiling breaks for Kenilworth. Home Guard 1st made it two wins this week as they won 5-2 away at Frames 3rd, with Ian Grindrod recording a 38 break. Bottom side Kenilworth S&S F/C lost for the second time this week, going down 4-3 at home against Lillington 2nd. Warwick Cons 1st were narrow 4-3 winners over Nelson 2nd and Harbury 1st were 5-2 winners away at Lillington 1st. In a re-arranged match, Home Guard 1st run out comfortable 6-1 winners away at bottom side Kenilworth S&S F/C, with Harj Dhesi recording a 40 break for the "guard".

In the A Division Frames 2nd finish the half way stage of the season 12 points behind leaders Harbury 2nd after a 4-3 win over Lillington Bowls. Priors 3rd are in third place following a 5-2 win at Cubbington 2nd. Priors 2nd gained an excellent 5-2 win over Bishops Tachbrook and Leamington Liberals came out on top in their derby with Oakhouse, winning 5-2 as Oakhouse only had 6 players available. Nelson 3rd run out 5-2 winners away at Home Guard 2nd. The match between Lillington 3rd and Kenilworth Cons 2nd was postponed. A Division leaders Harbury 2nd were handed their match with Warwick Cons 2nd 7-0 last week as Warwick Cons could not raise a team, although the match may be re-played at a later date.
