

Warwickshire Beer Leamington & District Snooker League

In the match of the week in the Warwickshire Beer Premier Division, Cubbington 1st played host to fellow title challengers Frames 1st. A closely fought match saw the home side stretch their unbeaten record to seven matches with a 4-3 win. Frames remain top but Priors 1st have closed the gap to just two points following a 5-2 win away at Warwick Cons 1st. Lillington 2nd recorded a shock 4-3 win away at title chasers Nelson 1st, and there was another shock as defending champions Kenilworth Cons 1st went down 4-3 at home against a Home Guard 1st side that have now beaten 4 of the top 5 sides. There were breaks from Ian Wagstaff (40) and Adam Ashley (41) for Kenilworth, and from Steve Maltby (37) and Ian Grindrod (31) for Home Guard. Harbury 1st won for the fifth match in a row with a 4-3 success away at Frames 3rd, and Kenilworth S&S F/C were also 4-3 winners at home against fellow strugglers Frames 4th. In the final match of the week, Lillington 1st won 4-3 against Nelson 2nd.

A Division leaders Harbury 2nd continued their winning run with a 4-3 win at home against Nelson 3rd. Frames 2nd pulled to within 9 points after they were impressive 7-0 winners over struggling Cubbington 2nd. Frames captain Mike Deas compiled a 32 break during the match. Priors 3rd continue to pursue the top two as they defeated Bishops Tachbrook 5-2, and Priors 2nd enjoyed a 4-3 home win over Warwick Cons 2nd. Lillington Bowls heaped more misery on bottom side Oakhouse with a 7-0 whitewash and Lillington 3rd were defeated 4-3 at home by Leamington Liberals. Finally, Home Guard 2nd enjoyed a 5-2 home win over Kenilworth Cons 2nd.
