

Warwickshire Beer Leamington & District Snooker League

Things are much closer at the top of the Premier Division now following some close, and shock results this week. Leaders Frames 1st battled to a 4-3 win over mid table Harbury 1st. Billy Morton (39) and Terry Robinson (32) were among the breaks. Their lead has been cut to five points now, as Priors 1st bounced back from last week's disappointing defeat to win 6-1 away at Kenilworth S&S F/C. Defending champions Kenilworth Cons 1st are level with Priors following a 6-1 home win over Warwick Cons 1st, with Keith Smith (40) and Ian Wagstaff (38) compiling breaks. Nelson 1st also draw level on points with Priors, a 38 break from Kelvin Handley helping them inflict a second derby whitewash on Nelson 2nd this season. Cubbington 1st are a point behind after struggling to a 4-3 home win over relegation threatened Frames 4th. Home Guard 1st bounced back from their previous week whitewash defeat to win convincingly at Lillington 2nd, a break of 41 from Harj Dhesi helping them to a 6-1 win. Steve England recorded a 40 break to win Lillington's frame. Frames 3rd were 5-2 winners in their match with Lillington 1st.

Harbury 2nd further strengthened their position at the top of the table after two wins in a week. A 7-0 win over bottom side Cubbington 2nd last week was followed by a 5-2 win over Leamington Liberals in a re-arranged match on Monday. They are now a massive 15 points clear of nearest rivals Frames 2nd. Frames enjoyed a 5-2 win at Home Guard 2nd to remain 5 points ahead of third placed Priors 3rd who also won 5-2 against 6 man Nelson 3rd. Priors 2nd won a close match 4-3 against Lillington Bowls, for whom Martin Hunt compiled breaks of 33 and 32. Lillington 3rd only had five players available for their match with strugglers Oakhouse, but still run out 4-3 winners overall, and Bishops Tachbrook overcame Leamington Liberals 4-3. Kenilworth Cons 2nd defeated rivals Warwick Cons 2nd 4-3.
