

## Warwickshire Beer Leamington & District Snooker League

Frames 1st remain top of the table after whitewashing Nelson 2nd 7-0. Pash Jugpal (53) and Eddie Starzynski (31) compiling breaks. There was also a 7-0 win for defending champions Kenilworth Cons 1st away at Lillington 1st. That leaves them two points behind the leaders, and one point ahead of Cubbington 1st, who enjoyed a 6-1 win away at Frames 3rd. Mark White was among the breaks again with a run of 48. Vic Makh also recorded a 43 break. Two more sides with title aspirations met as Priors 1st hosted Nelson 1st. Nelson went 3-1 ahead, with Phil Parkin recording a 32 break. But an excellent comeback from Priors saw them win 4-3. The result though has left both sides a lot to do to remain in contention. Richard Moore compiled a 31 break as Harbury 1st were comfortable 6-1 winners over Lillington 2nd. Frames 4th sprung a surprise 4-3 win away at Home Guard 1st, and Warwick Cons 1st enjoyed a 5-2 home win over bottom side Kenilworth S&S F/C.

Harbury 2nd won the battle of the top two, winning 4-3 at Frames 2nd to increase their lead at the top to 16 points. Priors 3rd missed the chance to close the gap on Frames after they went down to a 5-2 defeat away at Lillington 3rd. Home Guard 2nd won 4-3 away at Oakhouse, and Priors 2nd won 6-1 at Cubbington 2nd.
