Defending champions Kenilworth emerged victorious 4-3 in a tight encounter, with Adam Ashley knocking in a superb break of 70. Leaders Frames 1st took advantage to extended their lead at the top to four points with a 6-1 win away at Warwick Cons 1st. Priors 1st hit back following their disappointing defeat to Frames 1st last time out, a 31 break from Jason Harvey helping them to a 7-0 whitewash of Lillington 2nd. There was also a 7-0 win for fifth placed Nelson 1st, with Phil Parkin compiling a 39 break. Frames 3rd moved into sixth with a 6-1 win over Kenilworth S&S F/C. A 35 break from Sam Blundell helped Harbury 1st to a 5-2 win over 5 man Home Guard 1st. Frames 4th did their survival hopes a world of good with a 5-2 win over relegation rivals Nelson 2nd.

Leaders Harbury 2nd slipped to a rare defeat away at Lillington 3rd, who won 4-3. Frames 2nd did not take advantage though, only pulking back one point, after they defeated Bishops Tachbrook 4-3. Ian Kelley compiled the highest break in the division this season with a run of 45. Home Guard 2nd drew level on points with Priors 3rd with a 6-1 defeat of their rivals. Nelson 3rd continued their recent good form with a 5-2 win over Lillington Bowls, with Tim Sambhi recorded a break of 30. Leamington Liberals enjoyed an excellent 6-1 home win over Kenilworth Cons 2nd and Oakhouse enjoyed a much needed win, 4-3 against Priors 2nd. Bottom side Cubbington 2nd are now six points adrift following 5-2 home defeat to Warwick Cons 2nd.
