

## Warwickshire Beer Leamington & District Snooker League

### PREMIER DIVISION

The title race has been flung wide open following a shock defeat for leaders Frames 1st this week. They went down 4-3 in their derby match against Frames 3rd. Sati Viridi compiled breaks of 33 & 32 for the 1st team. Kenilworth Cons 1st stormed to the top of the table for the first time this season following a convincing 6-1 win over Nelson 1st, a result which all but ends Nelson's own title chances. Adam Ashley was in scintillating form for the cons, compiling a break of 74. Phil Parkin continued his break building form with runs of 44 and 38, and Mark Hanlon also recorded a 31 break. Cubbington 1st are right back in the title hunt following a 6-1 win away at Kenilworth S&S F/C, with Mark White (59), Vic Makh (57) and Dean White (32, 32) among the breaks. Kev Robinson knocked a 32 break in as Priors 1st started well against Home Guard 1st. However having led 3-1 they just crept over the line to win 4-3. Harbury 1st were 6-1 winners at relegation threatened Nelson 2nd, and Warwick Cons 1st moved closer to safety with a 4-3 win over relegation rivals Frames 4th. Lillington 2nd won their derby against the 1st team 4-3.

### A DIVISION

Leaders Harbury 2nd clinched promotion with a 6-1 win over third placed Priors 3rd. They now need just one point to clinch the A Division title. Frames 2nd are 10 points clear in second place after a 4-3 win over Nelson 3rd. Priors 2nd gained an excellent 5-2 win away at fourth placed Home Guard 2nd with vice captain Nick Darwen compiling a 30 break. Oakhouse continued their decent form of late with a 5-2 home win over Warwick Cons 2nd, and there was also a win for Kenilworth Cons 2nd, 4-3 away at bottom side Cubbington 2nd. Lillington 3rd retained their outside chance of promotion with a 4-3 win over Bishops Tachbrook. Elsewhere Lillington Bowls were 4-3 winners at home against Leamington Liberals.
